### Visiting the Sick

It is one of the corporal works of mercy to visit the sick. And it  
is (usually) very much appreciated by the person who is sick.

Sometimes though visiting the sick can run into some  
difficulties, so here are some suggestions that might help.

When you visit:

**Don't shout. The sick person is rarely deaf.**

**Don't talk about the sick person. Talk to them.**

**Don't have a party around the bed.**

**Don't stay too long. Five minutes is fine.**

**Don't whisper in the doorway. It upsets.**

**Don't tell the sick person about your problems.**

**Don't exaggerate when you report home.**

**Don't tell the sick person it could be worse.**

Do visit the sick person when they get home.
