## Good Practice Procedures

Glenamaddy parish is committed to having the following procedures in place. These Procedures and Code of Conduct will be made known to both parents/guardians and to children and young people:

- \* A code of conduct for children, young people and all adults who work with them.
- \* Procedures for recruiting, overseeing and supporting adult leaders working with children and young people.
- \* Appropriate supervision ratios of adults to children and young people.
- \* Adequate record keeping processes.
- \* A clearly communicated Accident/Emergency plan e.g. First aid, contact numbers, etc.
- \* Procedures to respond to internal conflicts and disciplinary issues
- \* Procedures for reporting Child Protection concerns and complaints.
- \* The Archdiocese has appointed two Designated Persons to whom all relevant concerns and/or complaints are brought. He/she will respond promptly and will liaise with the required civil authority and church authority.
- \* The parish will have its own Child Welfare Representative whose responsibility will be:
  - \* To promote awareness of the Church’s child protection policies.
  - \* To ensure that the public has ready access to contact details for the Designated Person and the relevant HSE officials.
  - \* To facilitate anyone in the parish in bringing an allegation or suspicion of child abuse to the attention of the Designated Person should they wish to have such support.
- \* The parish is committed to healing and reconciliation. Support persons are available to both victim and accused.

## Confidentiality Statement

The parish is committed to keeping confidential all personal information about children and their families. The only exception may be when child protection concerns arise in relation to a child. In this situation information will be shared on a need to know basis in the best interest of the child.
