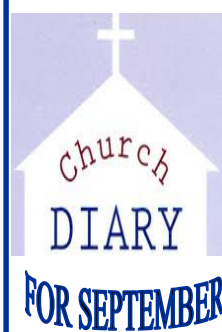
GLENAMADDY BETHANY BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP
