GLENAMADDY BETHANY BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

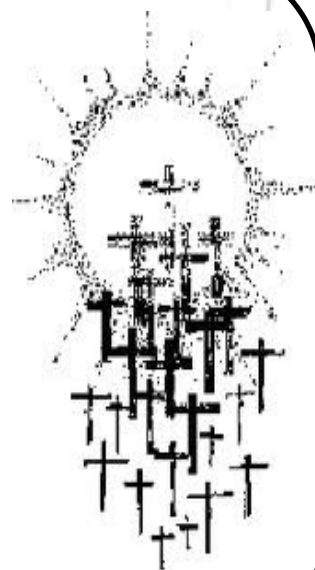
is a parish based group ministry whose aim is to help those bereaved and grieving. If at any time you feel a need to talk we are here to listen.
