PASTORAL CLUSTER

Our Pastoral Cluster (Dunmore, Glenamaddy, Kilkerrin-Clonberne
and Williamstown) is one of 15 in the Tuam Archdiocese. These
cluster groups were set up in response to the changes taking place
in the Church. Although the shortage of priests is a major concern
for the Catholic Church at this time, this is not the only reason for
the establishment of clusters. One goal is to get lay people more
active in Church activities: another is to get new ideas and involve
lay people in decision making. We started by raising awareness,
within our parishes, of the cluster. We have Mass times of all
churches in all the newsletters every weekend. The priests swap
Churches from time to time so the congregation will see a team of
priests working together within the cluster, rather than each parish
having its own priest. In autumn, we hope to establish Baptismal
teams. A Pastoral Cluster committee was formed and the following
officers were elected: Chairperson PJ Rabbitte, Secretary Breda
Keaveney, Treasurer John Meehan, PRO Nancy Lyons, Vice Chair-
person Pdraic Keady, Assistant Secretary Annette O'Rourke, Diocesan
meeting delegates Michael Jennings and James Donnellan.
