GLENAMADDY BETHANY BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

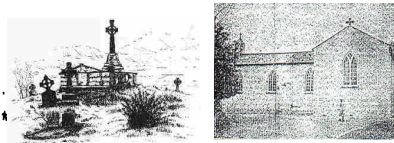
is a parish based group ministry whose aim is to help those bereaved and grieving.
