A teacher from Primary School asked her students to write an essay about what they would like God to do for them... At the end of the day, while marking the essays, she read one that made her very emotional.

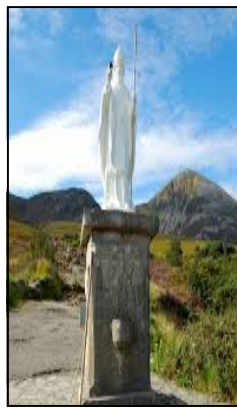
Her husband, who had just walked in, saw her crying and asked her:- 'What happened?' She answered- 'Read this. It is one of my students' essay.'
