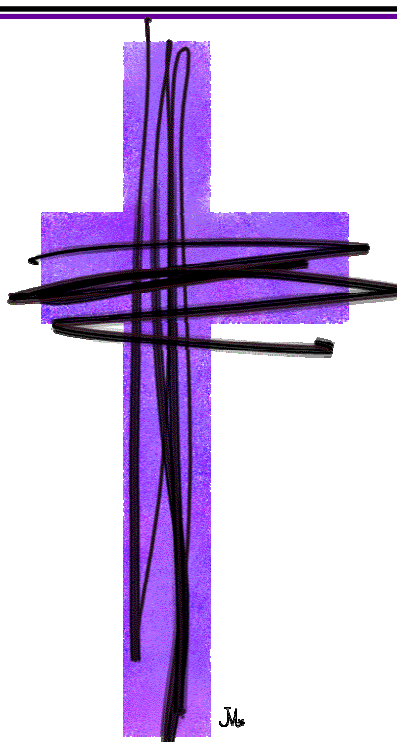
Glenamaddy Bingo: is on Wednesday nights in the Community Centre at
