#### What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

From the 1st Sunday of Advent we will be starting a Children's Liturgy. What that means is that children (Junior and Senior Infants and 1st Class children) will have the opportunity of celebrating the Liturgy of the Word at a level that is more appropriate to their age and understanding.

As parents, if you wish, your children will be brought to the Convent at the opening prayer of the Mass until the offertory. There, adult volunteers will work through the readings with them.
