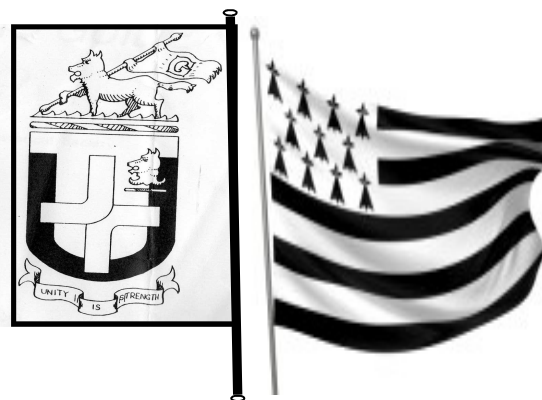

**THANKS** from the Bingo Committee to the Community School for the use of the school for Bingo and Nigel for all his help.

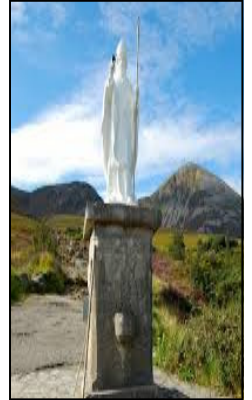
