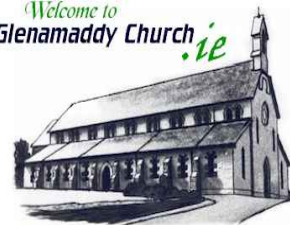

Divine Mercy Devotions at 3pm every Friday.

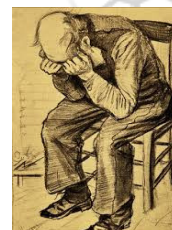
