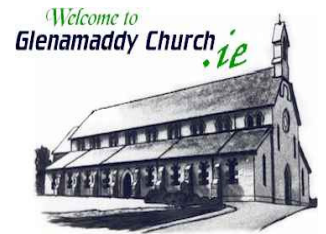

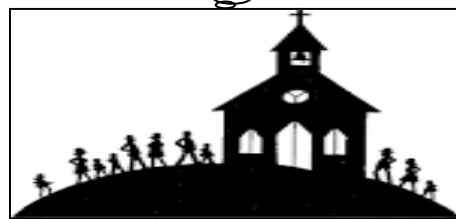
We ask you this, confident that you are our Saviour, and that you live and reign, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, now and forever.
