Who is in our Cluster?

The parishes of Glenamaddy, Williamstown, Dunmore, Kilkerrin and Clonbern form part of our Cluster. There are 15 clusters in the Archdiocese of Tuam. We have a Cluster committee set up over three years and the members are made up of our three priests and representatives from the Pastoral Councils in each parish.

What does the Cluster do? Each parish has their own identity but there are areas where all parishes can work together. An example of this is our baptismal teams which are up and running in all of the parishes in the cluster. Baptisms are structured that each parish has a different weekend for baptisms which is set up in such a way that if a priest is sick or on holidays the other two priests in the cluster can help out. This is also the case with weekend Masses. At present we are working hard at planning our upcoming Cluster Mission which will take place from the 3rd to the 11th October next.
