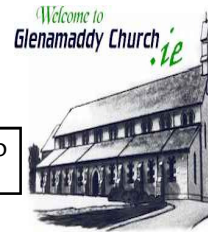


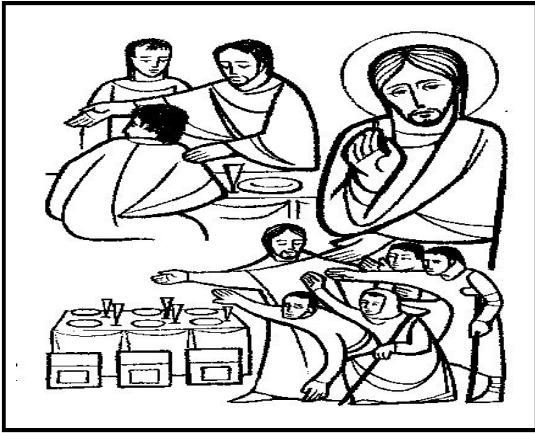

On this Sunday 4th September the woman known to us as Mother Teresa of Calcutta will be raised to the Altar of God in being Canonised a Saint in



St. Peter's Square Rome. This is the fulfilment of a wish for many and for the late Pope Saint John Paul II. The journey to Sainthood begins during one's lifetime by the way one lives and no one has ever questioned or doubted the holiness of Mother Teresa. During her lifetime she was often described as a 'Walking Saint'. With time this has been acknowledged as she is raised to the fullness of recognition as a SAINT. She wrote of herself: "I am Albanian by birth. I am a citizen of India. In my work I belong to the whole world. But in my heart I belong to Christ".
