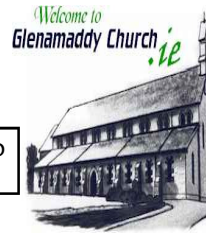

You see, it seems like just a blink ago I first held him in my arms, it's been my job to love, to teach, to keep him safe from harm. So, when I wave goodbye in a moment and he turns to walk inside, forgive me if I crumple into tears of loss and pride. I know as I give him one more kiss and watch him walk away, that he'll never again be wholly mine as he was before today. **With love from a parent.***

You'll always be their mother, whilst teachers come and go, to them you are their number one, this I truly know. Soon you'll see some changes, in your little girl or boy, they'll become more independent and to see this, it's a joy! I'll teach them all I have to give, to share, climb and to write, but to you they safely will return to tuck them in at night. **With love from a teacher.***
