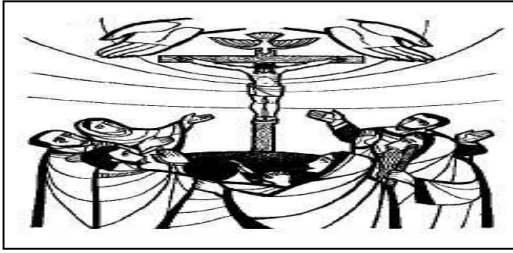

### The Vatican addresses Climate Change—Glenamaddy parish responds

*Laudato Si* is Pope Francis' Encyclical on the environment or more formally – On Care for Our Common Home. *Laudato Si* means "Praise be to you" which is the first line of a canticle by St. Francis that praises God with all of his creation: **To celebrate this and the Year of Mercy** we will be working with the teachers and the children of our three primary schools in creating awareness of our environment and how we should respect and leave it for future generations. We will be celebrating a special Mass on Saturday 11th June at 7pm in our church with a theme of protecting and nourishing our common home. There will be an opportunity for everyone to have a cuppa after Mass. On Sunday at 12 noon we will walk the Greenway from Frass-Englishtown and enjoy reflections along the way. This is a most important opportunity to do our bit as a parish to protect and respect our environment.
