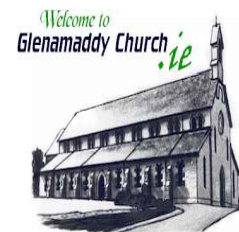

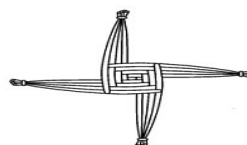

BLESSING OF THROATS on Wednesday at 7pm in Williamstown. It is the Feast of St Blaise. Blaise lived in Armenia in the 4th century. Traditions tell us that a boy with a fish bone caught in his throat was brought to him and was saved. It is around this belief that the blessing of throats on this day has been built.

MASS FOR THE SICK will be celebrated in St Patrick's Church, Glenamaddy on Thursday 11th February (World Day for the Sick) at 6.30pm for those who are sick. Any sick person who is present and those feeling the burden of their years may receive the anointing of the sick on the night.
