Then plant five rows of lettuce

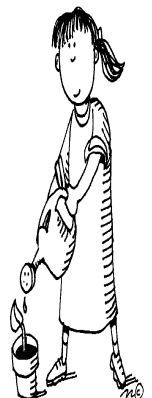
Let us be faithful: Let us be thankful: Let us be truthful:
