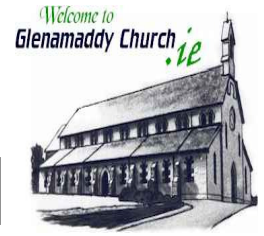

Papal Visit Sunday 26th August - Maynooth Traffic & Pedestrian Management Plan

Maynooth University is the significant transport Hub for persons going to the Phoenix Park to attend the Papal Mass. All vehicular traffic with parking permits for the Maynooth Hub carparks will be directed to the carparks via the N4 Kilcock (Edit 8) and travel through Kilcock town to Maynooth. This is the only route to access this facility. Gardai will then guide you to the train.
