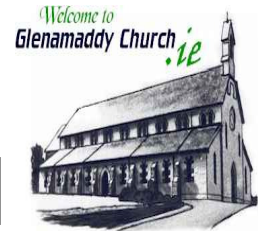

Next Wednesday 6th March is Ash Wednesday. There will be Mass in Williamstown church at 10am and in Glenamaddy Church at 7pm. Again as in the last two years we will be having our 'Drive thru' Ashes from 8am to 9.30am to facilitate people who are sick, advanced in years or with very young children, people on their way to work, hospital appointments etc. Our church lends itself to a drive through facility where you can drive in one gate, receive your ashes after answering the question 'Do you wish to live a holy lent?' (Receive the ashes) Turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel. You don't have to leave your car and when finished you can drive out the other gate. Every year Glenamaddy church reaches out to people to meet them where they were at. Fr Paddy said 'Jesus himself left the synagogue and went out to meet his people'. This new initiative by Glenamaddy Pastoral Council was welcomed by people from all over the world.
