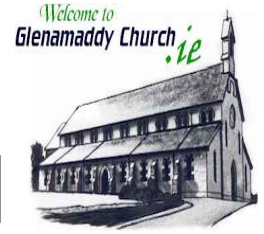

World Missions Ireland is the only Catholic charity which supports the 40% of the Universal Church that is too new, young or poor to support itself. It follows Christ's example by helping everyone in need, regardless of background or belief. Through World Mission Sunday, and your generosity, World Missions Ireland helps to:
