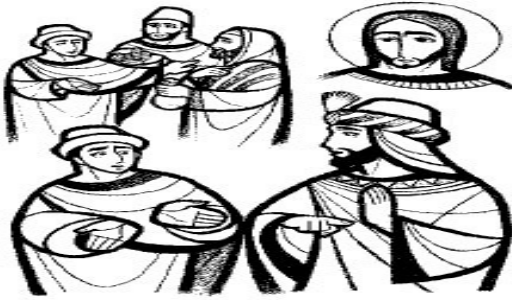
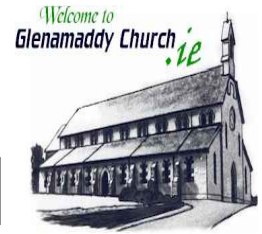

Prayers for the Sick

Next Sunday the 1st Sunday of October families are invited to take a night light home which will be available in our Church. You are asked, if possible, to light it each day around 6pm which is Angelus time. Burn it for ten or fifteen minutes while praying or eating. By doing so we will create a 'circle' of prayer and will be united in 'lighting the way' for all those who are sick in our parish. The few weeks ahead of our Special Mass for the Sick (Tuesday 22nd October at 7.30pm) will give us an opportunity to focus on all those who have asked our prayers. As well as the time given during our 'Circle of Light' time, why not give a few moments by visiting the Church or attending Mass even on one day during the week. Maybe your family prayer might be to say the attached prayer with your candle or a decade of the Rosary. Our prayer is: "God our Father, your love guides every moment of our lives. Hear our prayers for the sick people, we know and love. Amen."
