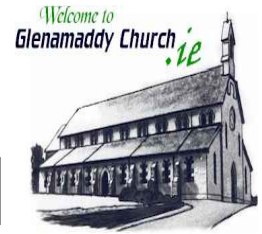

### **Tax Relief & Tax Refunds for Glenamaddy church**

Would you be willing to make a donation that won't cost you a cent? Believe it or not, you can! As a charitable body, it is possible for the Parish to obtain tax refunds from the Revenue on donations made to our Parish. If you contributed €250 or more in the past year your contribution can be increased by €180 or more. All you have to do is complete a CHY2 Tax Refund form. Please complete the form which is left in the church porch or which you received by letter a few months ago and return it to the Parish Office. This is a vital source of income for our Church.

Examples: John is a self employed carpenter and during 2017 donated €500 to his parish. The parish claims a refund from the Revenue of an additional €224.63. The parish gets the initial €500 donation plus the €224.63 tax refund = € 724.63.

Mary works part time as a PAYE tax payer and also has some self-assessed income tax to pay and during 2015 donated €500 to the parish envelope collection. Mary also made a once-off donation of €250 towards church refurbishment. The parish claims a refund from the Revenue of an additional €336.96. The parish gets the initial €750 donation plus the €336.96 tax refund = €1,086.96.
