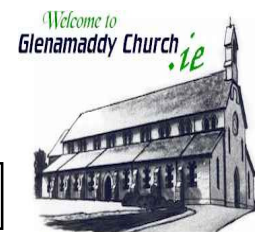

I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

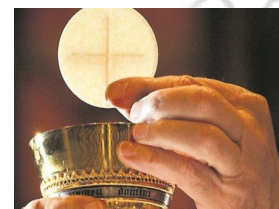
I love you above all things,

Holy Week - Easter Sunday 2020

Passion (Palm) Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. We know the story, the cruelty, the suffering and the sorrow. On Easter Sunday we celebrate “the Great Day”, Day of the Lord – His Resurrection. Hopefully, we too will recognise – say like the crowd at the end of the great week– “In Truth this was The Son Of God”.

This year will be very different to other years. STAY AT HOME is the advice to everyone at present. It is important that the Church supports the efforts of Government in our joint care for the common good in the face of these unprecedented circumstances and times. The necessary prudent measures enacted by our Government to prevent and slow infection rates during this current pandemic come with a great many sacrifices. No Palm - No Penitential Services - No Washing of The Feet on Holy Thursday night - No Public Veneration of The Cross on Good Friday - No gathering for the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night. Our Parish Church will be without a congregation.

However, I invite you to join in the celebrations of Holy Week and Easter from your homes through the medium of local radio. Please continue to reflect and pray in your homes. Our church will remain closed as we cannot guarantee that the church will be sanitized at all times.

SUNDAY COLLECTION/PRIEST’S COLLECTION ENVELOPES –I have had a few enquiries concerning the Sunday envelopes. Some parishes have online donations; The best solution is to continue to make your contribution into the Sunday envelope every week and when Masses/church services resume, please bring the church envelopes to the church. I have no doubt that the faithful parishioners will follow this advice. Thank you for your concern in this matter.

THE DIVINE MERCY NOVENA begins on Good Friday. You can recite the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy every day as it is a very appropriate prayer for these challenging times. St. Faustina prayed this Chaplet many times especially for the dying, and Jesus asked her to encourage others to say it too, promising extraordinary graces to those who recited this special prayer which we can offer for our own personal intentions also.

I will leave you with this prayer for Holy Week and Easter.

Dear Guardian Angel,

Go for me to the church, there kneel down at Mass for me. At the Offertory, take me to God and offer Him my service: What I am, what I have, offer as my gift. At the Consecration, with your seraphic strength, adore my Saviour truly present, praying for those who have loved me, for those who have offended me, and for those now deceased, that the blood of Jesus may purify them all. During Holy Communion bring me the Body and Blood of Jesus uniting him with me in spirit, so that my heart may become his dwelling place. Plead with Him, that through His sacrifice all people throughout the world may be saved. When the Mass ends, bring home to me and to every home, the Lord’s blessing. Amen
