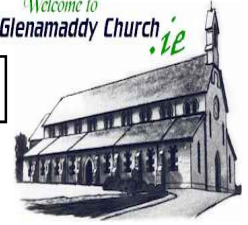

## **VOLUNTEERS**

Thanks very much to those who offered to help to sanitize and steward at church. Training will take in Glenamaddy church at the following times;-

### **WEDNESDAY 8TH JULY**

7pm-8pm for those who volunteered to sanitize.

8pm-9pm for those who volunteered to steward.

If you cannot attend on Wednesday please contact the Parish Office.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays since the beginning of restrictions will remain removed.

Church will reopen to a congregation on Saturday 26th July at 7pm.

All Government guidelines will have to be strictly adhered to. If you experience any of the following symptoms coughing, shortness of breath, fever please self isolate and contact your GP. Please do not come to church or Mass.

Please continue to obey the HSE guidelines by keeping a Social distancing of 2 metres, sanitizing your hands and if coughing or sneezing please do so into your elbow or tissue.

**Booking a space at Mass** There will be a booking number available in advance of our church reopening which you can phone in order to book a place at Mass in the church. Numbers will be limited inside of church. 2 metres social distancing applies with the exception of when persons are from the same household, they may sit together.

**Altar Servers** will be introduced at a later stage

**Toilets** will remain closed.

**Eucharistic Ministers** will wear face masks and will have a training session.

**People attending Mass in church** are recommended to wear face masks.

**Midweek Masses** will continue to be celebrated during the week behind closed doors. They will be broadcast on local radio 106.6fm—106.8fm.

**Sunday collection envelopes** can be dropped in the baskets on entering the church from those attending Mass inside the church. For those in the car park they will be collected by the stewards at the exit.

**It is also recommended** that people do not congregate outside Church for a chat.
