Poor Aul Matt, One of Our Own

The Venerable Matt Talbot, the great Dublin inner city man departed this life 95 years ago this Trinity Sunday 7th June 1925 on his way to Sunday Mass. One of thirteen children born to Elizabeth & Charlie Talbot on 2nd May 1856 he was destined to become the great example of triumph over adversity Ireland has every been blessed with. A reformed drunkard, he turned his life around at the age of 28 with the help of God and his Blessed Mother. Today Matt’s name is recognised with fighting addiction of all kinds and is looked to for support from so many people with addictions, those recovering from addictions and those called to share life with people who have addictions. Matt overcame his weakness with the help of God, sought for in prayer. He did not show off his beliefs but by the power of prayer and penance he gave a priceless example to generations after him. He lit his candles, he loved his statues and medals. He went to Mass, prayed the rosary, said his prayers.
