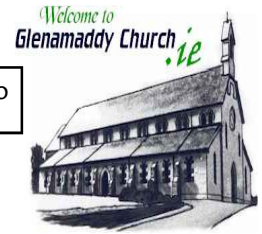

RE-OPENING SOON

After several very difficult weeks I am delighted in conjunction with Glenamaddy Pastoral Council to be able to welcome you back to St Patrick's Church for public Mass on Saturday 4th July at 7pm.

While this is very positive it is not without many challenges and restrictions.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays since the beginning of restrictions will remain removed.

Whilst the numbers are restricted from attending our 7pm Mass inside the church I encourage you to come as a faith community to Mass and remain in your car in the Church Car Park or Church grounds and tune into local radio. Holy Communion will be distributed in both the Church Car Park and Church Grounds. Those attending Mass inside the church are asked to park in the Convent or Community School grounds only. This week there will be outdoor speakers installed so that you can hear the Mass better in the grounds or car park if you can't tune into local radio. Mass will also be available on local radio from the comfort of your home.

All Government guidelines will have to be strictly adhered to. If you experience any of the following symptoms coughing, shortness of breath, fever please self isolate and contact your GP. Please do not come to Mass.

Please continue to obey the HSE guidelines by keeping a Social distancing of 2 metres, sanitizing your hands and if coughing or sneezing please do so into your elbow or tissue.

Booking a space at Mass There will be a booking number available next weekend which you can phone in order to book a place at Mass in the church. Numbers will be limited inside of church. 2 metres social distancing applies with the exception of when persons are from the same household, they may sit together.

Volunteers for Sanitizing and Stewarding the church: Thanks very much to all those who volunteered to help out. All volunteers will be trained.

Altar Servers will be introduced at a later stage

Toilets will remain closed.

Eucharistic Ministers will wear face masks.

People attending Mass in church are recommended to wear face masks.

Midweek Masses will continue to be celebrated during the week behind closed doors. They will be broadcast on local radio 106.6fm—106.8fm.

Sunday collection envelopes can be dropped in the baskets on entering the church from those attending Mass inside the church. For those in the car park they will be collected by the stewards at the exit.

It is also recommended that people do not congregate outside Church for a chat.
