

ADORATION every Monday except Bank holidays in the Convent House Oratory. 9am-12 noon. 6pm-10pm.



WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY The Summer General Meeting of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference concluded in Maynooth last week. During the meeting, bishops welcomed Pope Francis' message for the celebration of the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The World Day took place on Sunday 24 July with the theme 'In old age they will still bear fruit' (Psalm 92:15). Bishops acknowledged the central theme of the message, which is to promote dialogue among the generations, especially between grandparents and grandchildren and to bring together the wisdom of the elderly and the enthusiasm of the young.
