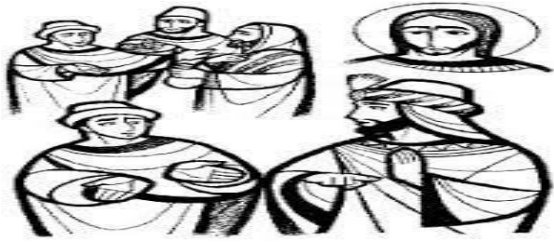
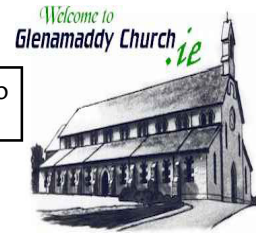

1st September - 4th October This years symbol: the burning bush The burning bush is the Symbol for the Season of Creation 2022.
