

OUR LADY OF KNOCK NOVENA 2022 — A Journey in Hope. The theme for this year's Novena is 'A Journey in Hope', as we look toward to the World Synod and reflect on the transformative power of hope and resilience in times of adversity. This theme of hope leads us towards thinking and reflecting more deeply on the Synod and the fundamental questions that remain at the heart of our continual discourse. We look to the future with the hope of renewal, for God's guidance and pray that this Novena will offer you, our pilgrims and friends the chance for thought-provoking reflection and discussion. Engaging on the Synod: A unique feature of this year's Novena will be the 'Synod Tent', where members of the public will be invited to learn more about the Synod and what it means for all of us. It will also provide an opportunity for us to listen to what you think Knock Shrine has to offer you and the Church in Ireland at this critical juncture in our history.
