This is just the beginning with the planting of the small acorn, and the involvement of many will result in the establishment of facilities for the future for our families and future generations. Pat Geraghty, Chairman of the Gents Club welcomed all, and President Mattie Potter gave a brief history of the club and the great work done by committees and volunteers since its foundation.
