

REPAIRS TO GLENAMADDY CHURCH

The condition of the Barges around our church are in decline and have become a health and safety concern. A contractor has been employed to carry out these works which will commence shortly. The project is costing in excess of €55,000 but we were lucky to secure a grant of €15,000. We hope to raise €40,000 to cover the remaining costs. We will have more information in next week's newsletter and also displayed in the notice board in the church porch.
