

Stages of run/walk

Stage 1 – Walk Distance 5.6km - Knock Shrine to Connacht Centre of Excellence, Bekan

Note that this stage is restricted to family only

Stage 2 – Run Distance 5.5km - Connacht Centre of Excellence, Bekan to Ballyhaunis GAA Club.

Stage 3 – Run Distance 10km - Ballyhaunis GAA Club to Lough Harps Soccer Pitch, Ballinlough.

Stage 4 – Run Distance 5km- Ballinlough National School to F45X594 on Williamstown Road.

Stage 5 – Walk Distance 4km - F45X594 (On Ballinlough to Williamstown Road) to Williamstown Football Pitch.

Stage 6 – Walk Distance 9.9km - Williamstown Football Pitch to Glenamaddy Vocational School, Kilkerrin Road.

Stage 7 – Walk Distance 5km- Glenamaddy Vocational School, Kilkerrin Road - Castletown Cross, Kilkerrin.

Stage 8 – Walk Distance 1 km - Castletown Cross, Kilkerrin to Kilkerrin Community Centre.
