

Mission Sunday this year falls today. The annual collection for the Propagation of the Faith will be taken up today. The theme of Mission Sunday this year is 'Hearts on fire, feet on the move'. This theme is inspired by the story of the disciples on the way to Emmaus, in the Gospel of Luke (24:13-35). Pope Francis, in his message for World Mission Sunday 2023, sends us on the walk to Emmaus with the two disciples and Jesus, risen from the dead. He tells us that we are formed in the Father's Love and sent out under the Son's command.
