### Irish Bishops Conference/HSE guidelines re. Swine Flu

Ill people should not attend Mass/Church. Stay at home for seven days from onset of symptoms.

Most people recover by staying at home, taking paracetamol and plenty of drinks

Spread of infection can be reduced by covering your cough or sneeze with a tissue and disposing in bin. Wash hands frequently with soap and water. Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth.

**Sign of Peace:** Shaking hands involves a low risk of spreading the virus by hand to hand contact. However, we will curtail this for the time being.

### **Holy Communion**

Those giving out Holy Communion should wash their hands beforehand. The chalice should not be shared

**Those who normally receive on the tongue are asked during this pandemic to receive on the hand**
